## ELIGIBILITY

1. Student must be a member of MWD Federal Credit Union in good standing.
2. Enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited university, college, community college, or high school.
3. Current grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
4. Submission packets containing all the requirements must be delivered to MWD Federal Credit Union by no later than July 10, 2017.

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Submit a completed application provided by MWD Federal Credit Union.
2. Submit a valid copy of your most recent report card or official transcript that verifies grade point average.
3. Submit an original 250 to 1,000 word typed essay on the above topic, suitable for publication.
4. Application and all supporting documents are to be submitted as a complete package only.  
*(Complete package consists of application, proof of enrollment and grade point average, and essay).*

### AMOUNT OF AWARD

One scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded. An award for any recipient under the age of 18 will be made to their parent or primary guardian.

### APPLICATION DEADLINE

MWD Federal Credit Union must receive the completed application, proof of full-time enrollment and 2.5 grade point average or higher, and essay no later than **July 10, 2017**. All submitted applications will be reviewed for compliance with application requirements by the Scholarship Committee of MWD Federal Credit Union.

### AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIP

The essays will be judged on quality, originality, and content. The winner will be notified by phone and by e-mail on July 31, 2017.
